Pastor's Column

The Annual Catholic Appeal

Jesus Christ is Risen – Alleluia!

Within the past couple of weeks, you received a letter from Archbishop Etienne and me introducing you to this year's Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). Each year at this time we pause and consider all the good that is accomplished because of your support of the ACA: the homeless are sheltered, retired priests and nuns are cared for, our seminarians are prepared to serve as our future priests, and so much more. If you haven't already done so, I pray you will join me in supporting the Catholic Church in Western Washington by giving to the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal.

Regarding the financial piece, our combined Archdiocesan and Parish goal for this year is \$210,000: \$154,000 will go to support the Catholic Church in Western Washington and the Archdiocese will give Holy Redeemer every dollar raised over that amount for our own project.

With that said, the most important goal is <u>participation</u> and we have set that goal at 100%. I invite you to join your fellow parishioners, along with thousands of other Catholics across Western Washington, to make a difference by making a pledge today.

When we meet our Annual Catholic Appeal goal, we will fulfill our responsibility to support over 60 ministries of the Archdiocese, and we will be able to set aside much needed funds to replace our three small storage sheds on the northwest corner of the parking lot with one much larger storage and maintenance building, increasing our storage capacity fivefold! 




