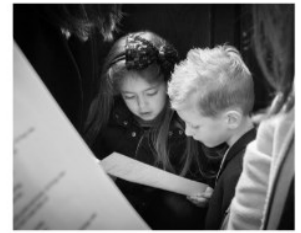

Pastor's Column

Growing in Virtue and Passing Them onto Our Children Fraternus and Fidelis

Jesus Christ: Yesterday, Today, and Forever ~

This week Holy Redeemer will embark upon a new program that teaches and models the virtues for all adults down to middle schoolers. It is called Fraternus for males and Fidelis for females. As long as you are between 12 and 100, you're welcomed and encouraged to come to our new Parish Night on Wednesdays. The format is simple: we will begin at 6pm with prayer, followed by food, an activity, a message about a virtue, sharing in a small group, and finish with prayer in the church. Men and boys will meet in the parish center, women and girls in the Annex (big green house on the west side of parish parking lot). You can register by going to our website's homepage and clicking on the button at the bottom of the page – or just show up, but registering helps us to plan. <https://holyredeemervan.org/parish-events/fidelisfraternus>

We are all aware of the crises of faith in our families and the world. The consequences of rejecting Jesus Christ: the way, the truth, and life, are devastating – divorce, adults not marrying, parents not marrying, fatherless children, broken and dysfunctional families, abortion on demand, pornography addiction, fornication/adultery/sodomy/transgenderism, depression, suicide, et cetera. What can be done? Amongst many things, learning and living the virtues.

While Holy Redeemer's catechists try to catechize willing adults and their children in the faith, over the past few years we have come to a greater appreciation of the need to teach and model the virtues too. What is a virtue? Simply put, a virtue is a good habit according to human nature. Let's unpack that.

An example of a good habit might be calling our elderly parents every week, or turning out the lights on time every night so we get up on time every morning rested and ready for the day, etc. But those habits are actions and the kind of virtues we're talking about are dispositions such as patience, kindness, chastity, courage, etc., dispositions that can be applied to multiple thoughts and actions throughout our day and life to better our lives and others. When we develop a virtue, we overcome our natural proclivity to selfishness and create a good habit that will improve our character and moral wellbeing in the process. We become more like God. But what do we mean by "according to human nature?"

God has created each of us in his own image and likeness, thus we have an aptitude to be like God in truth, goodness, and beauty; however, two things prevent that from happening in full. The first is, compared to God, our ability is limited or finite due to our not being infinite like God – nothing we can do about that. The second reason we struggle to be like God is that our nature fell in the Garden of Eden when our first parents sinned, hence our now fallen nature is inclined toward selfishness (not God like). As Christians, desirous of being like God, and thus enjoying life more and living with God forever in the next life; we strive to overcome our fallen nature through the practice of the virtues.

Mentoring Boys into Virtuous Catholic Men

Fraternus is a Catholic brotherhood for all ages. For over a decade Fraternus has been recovering the lost art of mentoring, harnessing the power of brotherly men and fathers, and teaching the virtues rooted in Christ as the path to authentic manliness.

This is not hyperbole: 40% of children in the US will be raised without their dad. Considering abuse and the many ways a father can be absent – emotionally, spiritually, and physically – the ripple effect of a fatherless generation is just beginning. And considering that the very mission of Jesus was to reveal the face of the Father (John 17:25-26), and that the turning of father's hearts towards their sons is central to God's plan of salvation (Malachi 4:6, Luke 1:17), and that fathers are meant to image God (Ephesians 3:15), we can understand why Joseph Ratzinger (Pope Emeritus Benedict) said: "The crisis of fatherhood we are living today is an element, perhaps the most important, threatening man in his humanity."

Fraternus Is a Brotherhood for All Ages

Through Fraternus, men are taught and given the framework to recognize their Christian brotherhood amongst themselves and to live it more clearly and boldly. Only after a fraternal culture exists amongst the men can you then invite the boys into it so that they too can become men. United in this way, Fraternus is not for one generation or another, but for all generations of men.

Fraternus Reaches the Fatherless

With rampant fatherlessness, Catholic men cannot ignore the "orphans" amongst them. Many mothers are doing their best with their sons in a fatherless home (or a home with a faithless father), but there's no replacing the role of a man in teaching masculine virtues and character. Boys need mentors to navigate their way to manhood. Fraternus provides the training and means for men to reach out to the fatherless in their community, inviting them into mature brotherhood.

Mission

Fidelis forms girls — heart, mind, body, and soul — into a sisterhood of mature, virtuous disciples of Christ through the witness of Catholic women.

Who We Are

Fidelis is a parish sponsored multigenerational program inviting girls in grades 6-12 into sisterhood with women, young and old, leading each other to Christ. With our 'yes' to God we use intentional, virtuous and feminine means to form girls into women who can proclaim with confidence to God, "Paratum cor meum Deus – my heart is ready, O God, my heart is ready."

What We Do

With the intent on capturing the heart of a young woman, Fidelis uses movie clips, activities, and games to teach virtue, all in the context of mentorship and sisterhood. Fidelis draws girls into the heart of the Church by connecting discussions on virtue to the Sunday Mass readings. These lessons come to life during weekly meetings, seasonal outings, and an annual Inspire trip where chapters from around the country gather.

Why We Do It

Fidelis invites women into a virtuous life through personal prayer, participation in the Sacraments, and meaningful involvement with their parish. As women grow in holiness, the Holy Spirit compels them to pass this on to the next generation. Fidelis forms young women not only by teaching about virtue but also by presenting living models of discipleship.
