## Pastor's Column

### Annual Catholic Appeal – Follow Up

Jesus Christ is Risen – Alleluia!

A few weeks ago, you received a letter from Archbishop Etienne, and one from me last week introducing you to this year's Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). Each year at this time we pause and consider all the good that is accomplished because of your support of the ACA: the homeless are sheltered, retired priests and nuns are cared for, our seminarians are prepared to serve as our future priests, and so much more. If you haven't already done so, I pray you will join me in supporting the Catholic Church in Western Washington by giving to the 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal. The support of every parish is critical to the success of the Archdiocese and its many ministries.

Regarding the financial piece, our combined Archdiocesan & Parish goal for this year is \$175,000. With that said, the more important goal is participation and we have set that goal at 100%. I invite you to join your fellow parishioners, along with thousands of other Catholics across Western Washington to make a difference by making a gift today.

When we meet our Annual Catholic Appeal goal, we will fulfill our responsibility to support over 60 ministries of the Archdiocese, and we will be able to set aside much needed funds to install security cameras on our parish campus and to increase our disaster preparedness and recovery plans and equipment. Over the years we've had problems with trespassing, vandalism and cars being broken into, especially during Mass (clever devils). We also have an ongoing problem with reckless drivers in our parking lot at all hours of the day and night. It's your generosity that will make the ministry of the Archdiocese and this much needed parish project a reality. I hope to be able to count on you and your good stewardship.

I am asking every household in the parish to commit to 1% of your annual household income or \$1.50 a day (\$550) (whichever is more) over the course of the next year. Some of us can commit to more than that, and we really depend on you to do that if you can, **yet every gift will make a difference so please commit to something**. # Meet Our New Administrator: Don Anderson



Words cannot express how honored and fortunate I feel to be asked to serve this parish as the new administrator. I am writing to provide you with a brief biographical statement.



I was born and raised in Portland, Oregon and I attended college at the University of Oregon and at Pepperdine University. While at the University of Oregon I met my wife Linda, and we got married while still in college. We are currently in year 42 of marriage. (The picture to the left is from our 4<sup>th</sup> year of marriage) We have been blessed with four wonderful children, a daughter in law, and two grandchildren who all attend Holy Redeemer.

After my college days ended, I attended Officer Training School with the USAF, and was commissioned a Lieutenant. I was a contracts negotiator for Space Systems Division at Los Angeles Air Force Base for five years. I have had a number of professional roles since my Air Force days to include managing pharmaceutical sales representatives, owning a sports performance business, and owning a recruiting firm as well.

My spiritual journey began early in life. My parents were Southern Baptists, and I was raised in that tradition. My grandfather was a Baptist preacher. By the time I came along, he was retired so I only heard him preach one time. But I do remember it was a "hell fire and brimstone" sermon. The Baptist tradition in which I was raised spent more time on hell than heaven!!

Every Sunday from as early an age as I can remember, it was Sunday School, followed by the church service, followed by dinner at my grandparents home. And it was that way for everyone in my social network. It was a wonderful way to grow up.

When I left home for college, I followed the traditional path of young people; I didn't set foot in a church again unless it was for a funeral or for a wedding for about 15 years. Then along came children. My wife insisted that children should be raised with a moral foundation, and she was raised Catholic. So off to the Catholic church we went. I agreed with her that children should be raised with a moral foundation, and I attended church because I wanted to set a great example for them. Not the best reason, but a good reason nonetheless.

I just wanted to warm the pew from 11:00am to 12:00pm and call it good. You know, sneak in and out of the side door and not get noticed. But God had different ideas. After about 5 years of listening to Fr. Mitchell, I began to wonder if what he was saying was true. I began to research and I began to think. (Thinking is always a dangerous business!!) Then an usher asked me to become an assistant usher. (I thought, oh no...I KNEW they would start asking for my active engagement!)

Then Fr. Mitchell asked me to be a part of the Evangelization Team. (Again, I thought, oh no....I KNEW they would start asking for more engagement.) Then Fr. Nathe asked me to be Administrator. (And I thought, "You've got to be kidding me!! More active engagement?")

I felt like Jonah.....the more I try to run, the more I get called!! (What will God send next, a whale?) But here has been the blessing: the more engaged I became, the more I grew in my faith.

So, there is the short version of my faith journey story. The moral to the story I think is this: get engaged.

What I learned was this: the more you put in, the more you get out. (Or as they used to say in the South: "What you give, is what you get".)

I am thrilled to be given an opportunity to serve you all, and I am thrilled to be given an opportunity to serve our God.

And I am also scared to death to follow in the footsteps of the greatness of Mr. Ed!

But fear is a great motivator.

And with your love and support I'm sure that together we will grow our parish in its mission to Glorify God and Sanctify Souls.

I am looking forward to serving you all in this new role.
