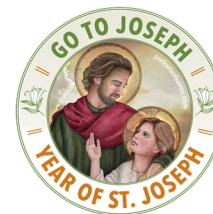

## Pastor's Column

April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021

### Sabbatical

Jesus Christ is Risen – Alleluia!

I've got some good news and some bad news. First the good: I'll be leaving for a sabbatical at the end of April and returning in early August. Now the bad news: I'll be leaving for a sabbatical at the end of April and returning in early August. Specifically, I'll be gone from Monday, April 26 through Tuesday, August 3. While I'm away, Fathers Martin and Woodman, both retired priests living in southwest Washington, will cover most of the weekend Masses. Fr. Martin will cover the weekday Masses as well. I am so grateful for all the priests who cover for me when I'm gone, we'd be closing down Masses without them.

Diocesan priests are entitled to a three month sabbatical every six or seven years. I've been a priest for nearly 17 years and this will be my first sabbatical. A sabbatical is a time for a priest to go away and further his studies. For me, it is also a time to recharge and reorient myself. I hope to do a lot of reading and praying, and a little bit of writing. Specifically, I'll be reading about the various stages in the spiritual life, from the life of a person who lives in a state of habitual mortal sin, to the very rare few who achieve the unitive state with God. I hope to share some of what I discover with you over the coming years.

Speaking of the coming years, Archbishop Etienne has formally re-upped me for another six years as your pastor, meaning that I will remain the pastor of Holy Redeemer until at least 2027. I wouldn't mind staying here for life. Perhaps things will work out that way.

In the next couple of weeks I'll write about our church completion project. We're getting very close to moving in.

## **PARISH HAPPENINGS**

**HOORAY!!!:** Effective Monday March 22 all of Washington moves to phase 3. This means we can seat 400 people in the Church! **NO MORE**

**MASS SIGNUPS.** You still need to wear a mask and practice good hygiene, we will still be wiping down door handles and pews. Every other pew will still be empty but families can sit right next to each other. So the open pews can be full of people (no 6' spacing side to side, only front to back). Please be welcoming and allow your fellow parishioners to sit next to you-it is kind and safe to do so.

We will continue to record the Masses so that those who cannot attend may participate at home.

**School Subsidy:** Holy Redeemer Parish provides per-pupil assistance for active parishioners who enroll their children in grades K-8 at Our Lady of Lourdes, St. Joseph, and Regina Caeli. This allows families to receive discounted tuition rates. The enrollment process of these schools requires authorization from the parish in order to receive the lower rate. The authorization is based on each family's completion of forms that verify their active involvement in the parish. These forms are available at the parish office and need to be completed each year for new **and returning families.**

Families who anticipate using this benefit should already be recognized as active parishioners. You must fill out and return the form distributed by Holy Redeemer and not any form received from the school. Forms must be completed and returned to Holy Redeemer by May 1, 2021.

Please note that while regular Mass attendance is a requirement for receiving subsidy, this requirement is on hold until COVID Mass restrictions are lifted.
